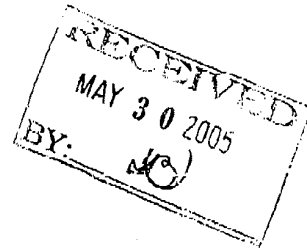

### CAPE ROYALE PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION FIREARMS, FIREWORKS, OPEN FIRES POLICY

- No firearm may be discharged within the boundaries of the Cape Royale Subdivision.  
Property Owners who are directly involved in the discharge of a firearm or indirectly involved by way of their family members, guest, workers, etc. all shall be held responsible for such discharge and subject to a penalty not exceed \$1,500.00 as determined by the CRPOA Board of Directors.
- The use of fireworks of any kind is prohibited within the boundaries of the Cape Royale Subdivision.  
Property Owners who are directly involved in the use of fireworks or indirectly involved by way of their family members, guest, workers, etc. all shall be held responsible for such use and subject to a penalty not to exceed \$1,500.00 as determined by the CRPOA Board of Directors.
- Open fires, including but not limited to, burning of trash, leaves clippings, and any other form of debris is expressly prohibited within the boundaries of the Cape Royale Subdivision.  
Property Owners who are directly involved in the use of open fires or indirectly involved by way of their family members, guests, workers, etc. all shall be held responsible for such use and subject to a penalty not to exceed \$1,500.00 as determined by the CRPOA Board of Directors.

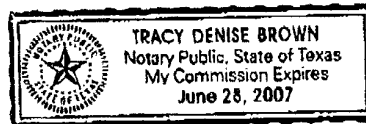
